



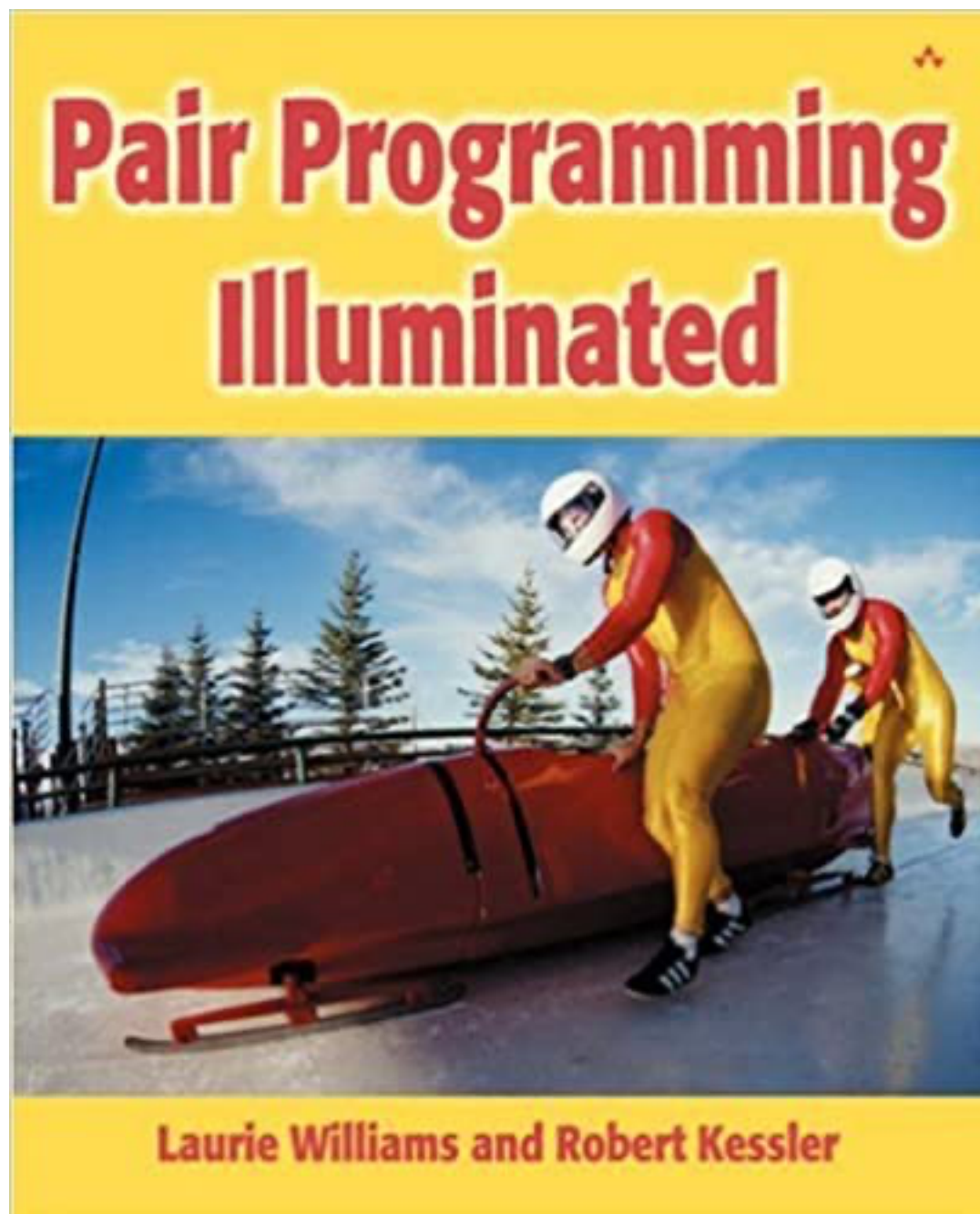

- use in-browser

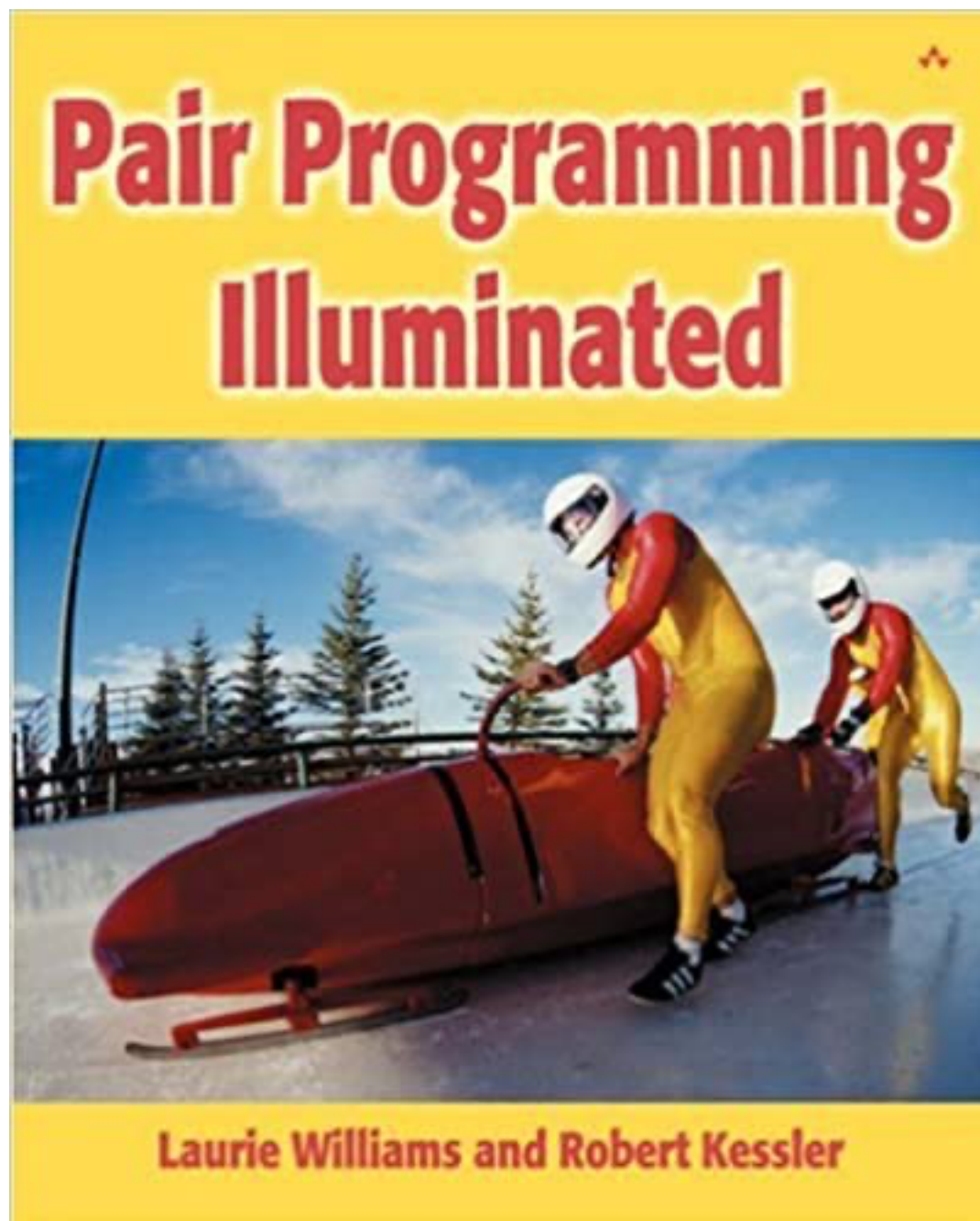
E: TCP

- your manager knows better

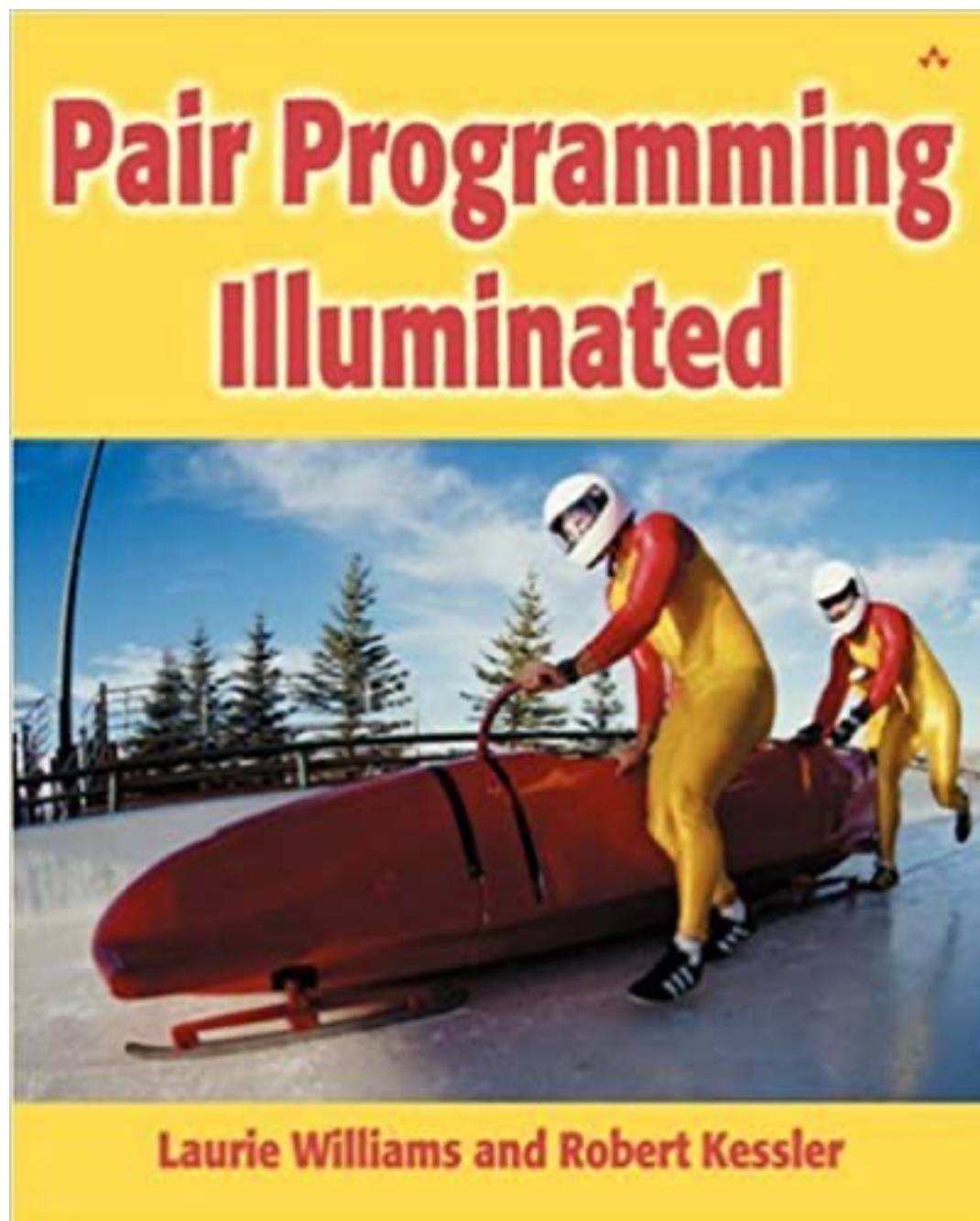




My partner is so much *weaker* than me.
